

THIS IS SOME OF WHAT THE TRUMP ADMINISTRATION HAS ACCOMPLISHED IN SIX MONTHS

JOB CREATION AND ECONOMIC GROWTH:

- The administration's pro-business agenda has resulted in companies keeping jobs here in the U.S. and significant stock market gains.
- Unemployment is down to 4.3%, over 600,000 new jobs have been added, and there is once again economic enthusiasm.
- Corrected several inequities in the Dodd-Frank law that will, among other things, help small banks to prosper. Because of Dodd-Frank, several hundred small banks went out of business and many small business loans were denied.

A NEW DAY AT THE UN FOR U.S. & ISRAEL:

- Under Ambassador Haley's leadership, the United States has criticized the UN Human Rights Council for their chronic anti-Israel bias.
- Worked with Israel's Ambassador to the UN, Danny Danon, on combatting BDS and anti-Semitism within the United Nations.

- The President approved plans and construction for the Keystone Pipeline which will lower consumer fuel prices, create jobs, and reduce U.S. Dependence on foreign oil.
